## Dear Dharma Friends,

When we first started building Tara Mandala, we often thought of it as a child—moving through the stages of the "terrible twos," the "fabulous fives," and then gradually into adolescence. Now, at 30, we are entering adulthood, and this feels just right for where we are today. Turning 30 has made me reflect on the beginnings and feel deep gratitude for all those who came alongside us, helping to shape this vision from the start. I remember those early years when Tara Mandala was just a magical piece of land in Southwest Colorado—no water, no roads, and no buildings.

I have so many fond memories from those early days. I remember one year, teaching in a large tent in the middle of Kapala Meadow when a thunderstorm suddenly rolled in from the West. The thunder cracked and lightning flashed, and we were surrounded by the raw power of nature. The storm was so intense that running away would have been more dangerous than staying put. So I told everyone, "Stay away from the metal tent poles, avoid sitting in puddles of water, and just meditate." We sat there, still and silent, as wind blew through the tent, rain poured, jagged flashes of lightning lit up the sky and thunder shook the earth. No one moved. After about half an hour of this intensity, it suddenly stopped. The sun broke through the clouds, and a double rainbow formed above the tent. We ran outside, dancing in joy and relief, with the scent of artemisia and sage filling the air.

After we began daily practice to Machig Labdrön's protector, Zangri Tsen Mar, who rides a red horse, a herd of wild horses—mostly chestnut in color—arrived. Now, every year on Machig's birthday, one or two red foals are born, and the wild horses are a constant presence on the land. This year, for the first time since 2009, we are embarking on a significant creation of a traditional Buddhist cremation site with a Zhitro temple, made possible by a generous gift. Another wonderful gift this year is the return of Cady Allione to her role as Executive Director. Cady's intelligence, heart, and leadership were crucial in guiding Tara Mandala through the challenging years following Dave's passing. I am deeply grateful that she has stepped back into this role, and I hope you all will come to know and appreciate her as much as I have over the past 20 years.

This past year, I also had the opportunity to travel and teach, mostly focusing on the theme of non-duality. One question I often began with was: "What if there's no problem?" In times like these—when political shifts, climate crisis, war, and the curtailing of women's rights weigh heavily on us—how can we even consider that there might be no problem? The answer lies in the vast, empty awareness that is always present, beyond time, without a center or edge. Mostly we're so caught up in our thoughts and problems that we're unaware of this boundless awareness. Turning the thinking mind to effortlessly experience its source, and to rest in that awareness, answers that question. The practices we engage in—whether it's nonduality meditation, deity yoga, prayer, or mindfulness—ultimately lead us to this awareness. So, I encourage you to ask yourself this question—"What if there's no problem?"—and rest in what you experience immediately after you ask the question.

Thank you, dear friends, for being a part of this community, for your support, and for walking this path with us.

Atop the slope of Ekajati peak, overlooking the Tara Temple, with mountain peaks shimmering in the distance, *Tara's Pure Land* will provide a serene and sacred place to hold traditional Buddhist cremations and the remains of Sangha members.

We've received a grant to bring this long-held dream of Lama Tsultrim's to life. In the Fall a new road was graded so we can prepare the land for the next phase of building, which will continue in the months and years ahead bringing the Zhitro Temple, Cremation Stupa, and Columbarium to life.



#### CILANTRO DRESSING RECIPE

- 2 cloves garlic
- 4 Serrano/Jalapeño chilis (seeds in for more heat, seeds and ribs out for less heat)
- 1 Tbsp (8 g) sea salt
- 4-6 bunches of cilantro washed and cleaned, stems included (they have great flavor!)
